



Curious Stitch in Time



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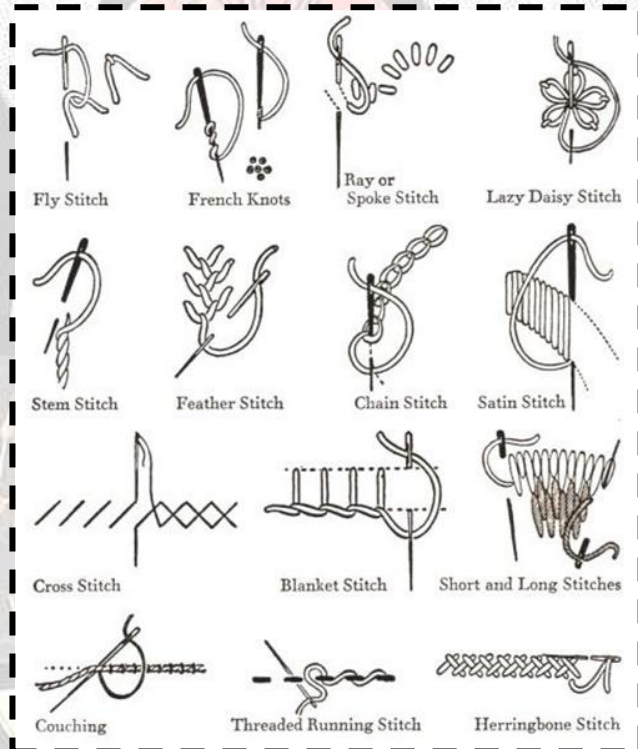
As part of the BHI Time Lines: Fall Back Event 2017, Curious are creating a patchwork of stitched timepieces. We're asking people to 'draw' with thread and decorate a fabric patch with time related words and images. Finished pieces will be collected together and joined into a textile panel for future display at the BHI Museum.

Cut a piece of cotton fabric just bigger than a postcard - 16 x 11.5cm. Draw on a clockface in pencil to stitch over and decorate around, using embroidery threads.



There are many stitches you could use to decorate the clock and a few ideas are suggested here:

You may want to think about a moment in time that is special to you, reference a story or poem or look at timepieces around your home, on the next page or on-line for patterns and decorative ideas.



What to do:

- When you've decide what you're going to sew, draw a pencil outline onto the fabric. You can draw words and/or pictures and patterns.
- Choose your stitches and sew over your pencil lines.
- When your piece is finished you can post or bring the patch to us at Curious to be added to the fabric panel. Alternatively, take a clear photo of the fabric and email or post to our Facebook page and we'll create a virtual patchwork to share.
- We would like the Time Lines patches returned to us by 30 November 2017, please.
- Finally, it would great if you'd be willing to attach a brief note saying what inspired your design or any stories relating to it.
